## **Have you ever been unable to afford your medications?**

Paying for prescription medications can be difficult. Prescription Assistance Programs and Drug Discount Programs could help. Other ways to reduce prescription costs include: 1) ask your doctor if there is a less expensive but equally effective alternative medicine available, 2) ask for the generic version of the medicine, or 3) ask your doctor for free samples.
