### **HUSKY is requiring proof of citizenship and identity**

To apply for HUSKY or renew your benefit, if you are a US citizen, you must now prove your citizenship and who you are. For most people, that requires that you show DSS your birth certificate. For most adults, you will need to show a driver's license or other official form of ID. For children, school or daycare records will do. You must show these documents when you first apply for HUSKY or at your next renewal/redetermination date. You should have received a notice from DSS about this policy.

If you don't have your birth certificate, a driver's license or other ID, or school/daycare records, call the HUSKY Infoline at 1-877-284-8759.

For now, no one is being thrown off HUSKY if they don't provide a birth certificate, but that will change eventually. Call us if you have questions at 1-888-873-4585.
