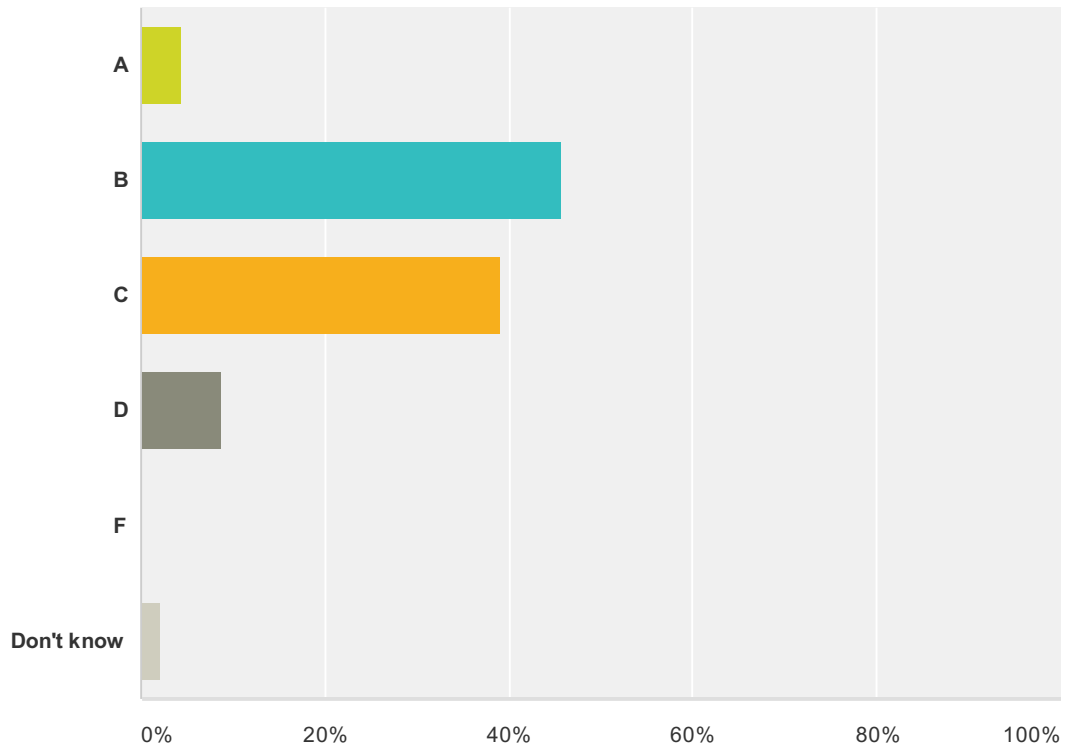


**Q1 What grade would you give Connecticut for progress toward reform overall?
Consider both private and public efforts.**

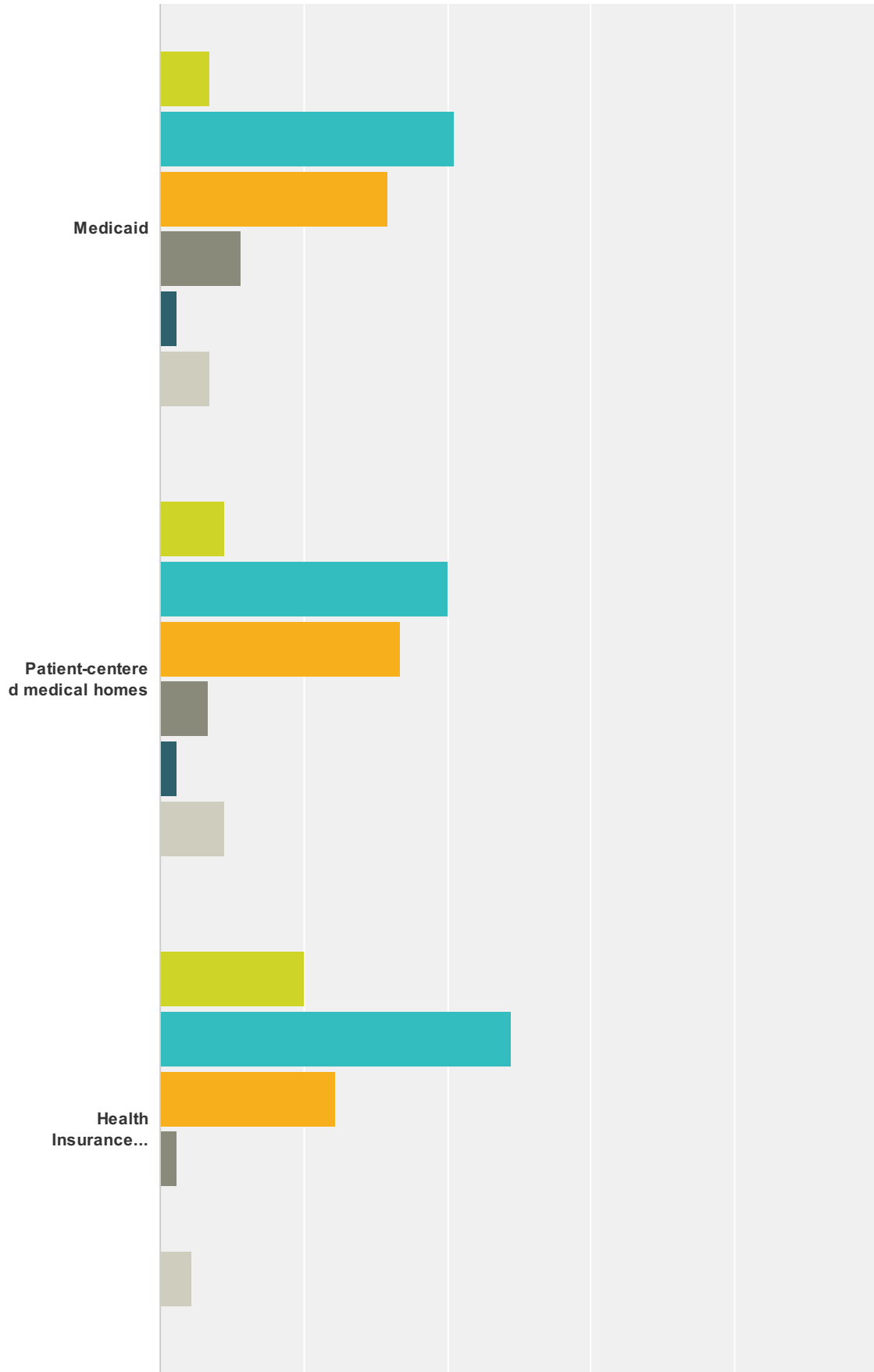

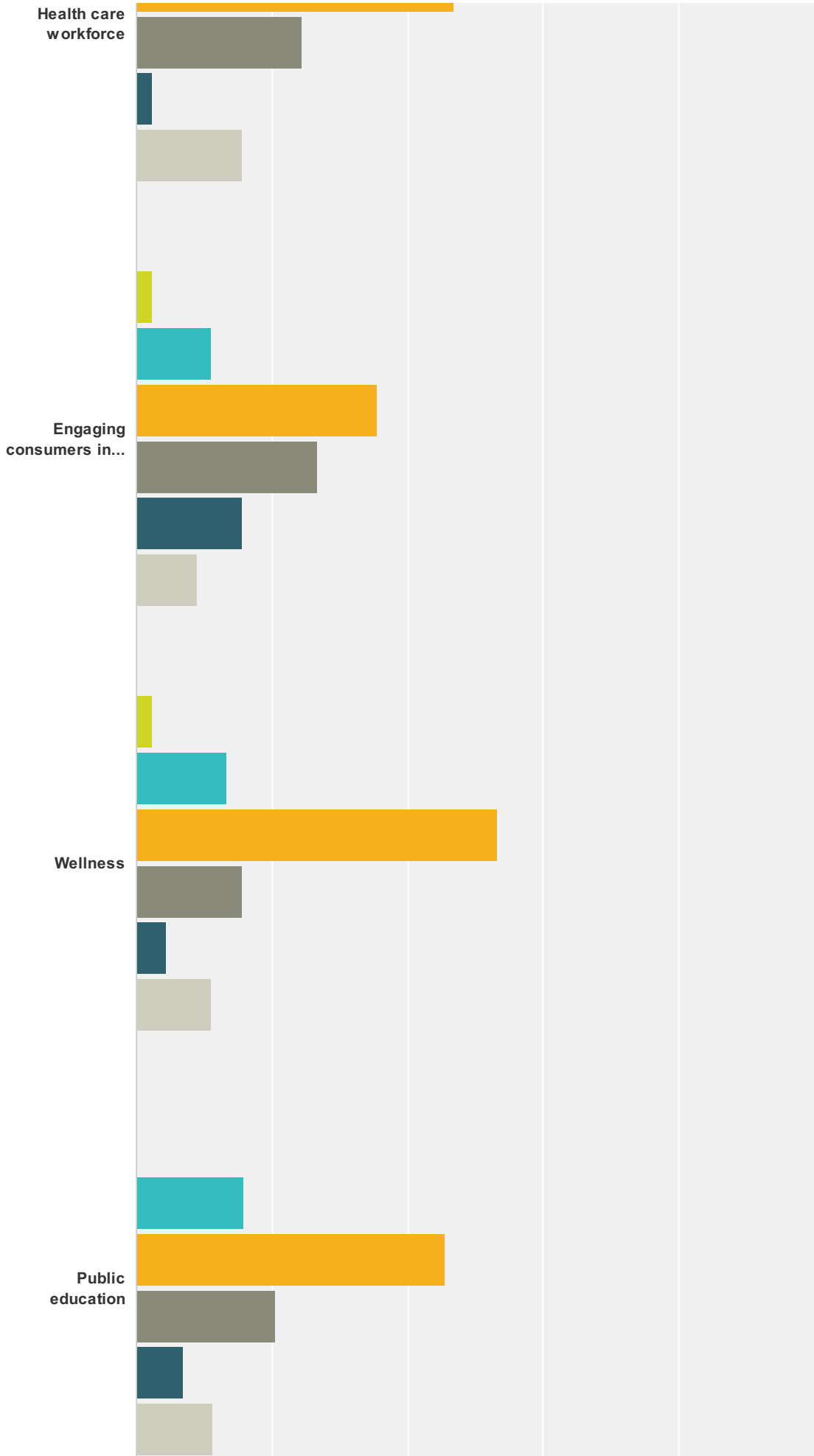

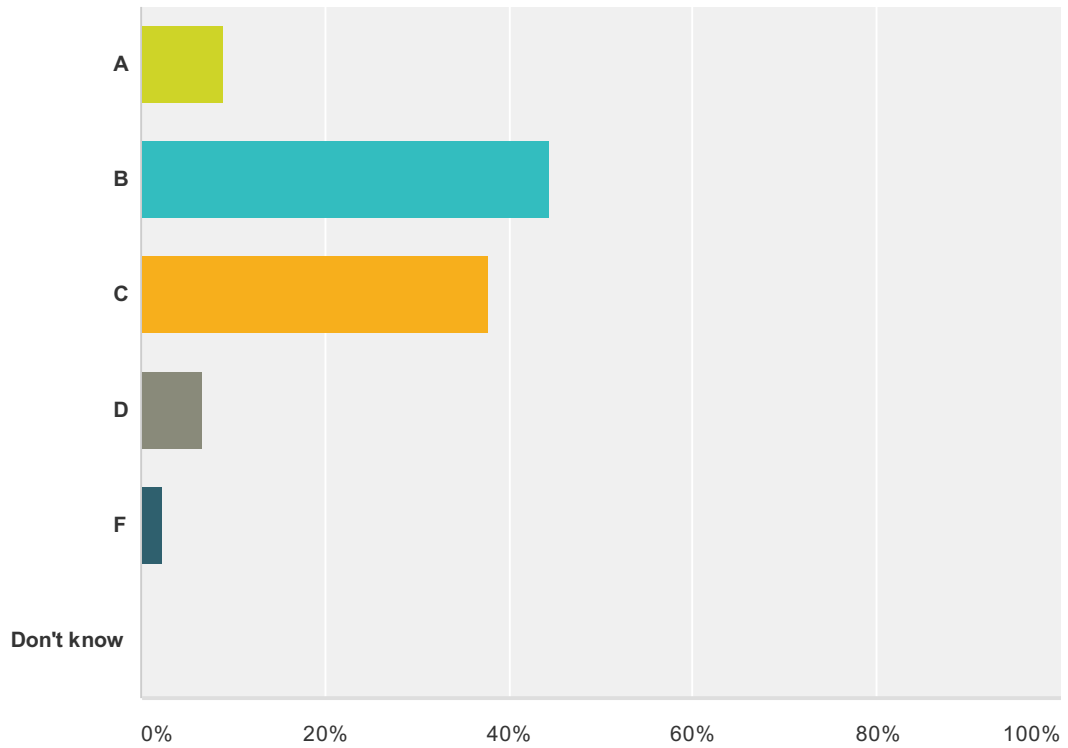
